"My Jesus, I Love Thee" Hymn History

"Sixteen year old William Featherston of Montreal wrote this simple hymn shortly after his conversion. He died at 26 with this being the only hymn he ever wrote. It first appeared in The London Hymnbook but was reprinted with a new melody by A.J. Gordon in Boston, Massachusetts for the church he pastored. Soon this version was being sung all across America. Even though Gordon had a remarkable ministry in New England, wrote several books and started a college and seminary, putting this simple hymn by a teenage boy to music may be the accomplishment that had touched the most lies of all."
