But when trust comes first, obedience follows out of love. The song was written by John Sammis one evening after an evangelistic meeting in Brockton, Massachusetts. One young man's testimony stated that he was not quite sure how he felt about his salvation but he was going to trust and then he was going to obey. Sammis had recently left his job in business to become a minister and was asked to write a hymn text on trusting and obeying. He wrote the chorus first and then 5 stanzas followed.
