"Late in 1943, Ruth Caye Jones, mother of five and wife to a busy pastor, was reading 2 Timothy 3:1 which says, "In the last days, perilous times shall come." She thought of the world around her, America was in the midst of WWII, Allied troops were marching up the boot of Italy, rationing was hitting hard, discouragement was everywhere. How long could people continue in times like these? Ruth took out a small notebook and wrote some words and a melody came to her as she wrote. She had no formal music training and wasn't trying to become famous. It was the right song for the right time. Soon people around the world were singing it. Years later, George Beverly Shea sang it at a Billy Graham crusade and brought tears to Ruth's eyes. She said, "I can't believe I had a part in writing this song. I just feel that God gave it to me, and I gave it to the world." The words and sentiment are still relevant today.
