"Battle Hymn of the Republic" Hymn History

"Julia Ward Howe wrote these lyrics during the heart of the Civil War. She made no reference to either side of the conflict, only sought to write some wholesome, uplifting words for the tune "John Brown's Body Lies A-Moldering in the Grave." It can be dangerous to identify political causes or even national patriotism with God's Truth. Nations may rise and fall, but God's truth remains the same forever, "His truth is marching on". The text is filled with biblical allusions, Revelations 14:19, "grapes of wrath:, Revelations 8, the sounding trumpet for example. For the Christian, the song's message is clear; although circumstances may appear overwhelmingly difficult, God will still accomplish His purposes. His truth will endure eternally.
