"Come, Christians, Join To Sing" Hymn History

"This hymn was originally written for children. Both of the terms, alleluia and amen. Alleluia is found frequently in Psalms and means "praise the Lord". Amen ends the last book of the New Testament and means "assuredly, indeed, or so be it". We use amen at the end of prayers but in the Bible, it sometimes begins Jesus' statements. Different versions translate it as "verily" or "truly" but it's still amen. All of God's promises are "amen" in Christ, and that is enough to make us sing both "alleluia" and "amen".
