"The Solid Rock" Hymn History

"Edward Mote, the son of a pub owner in London, was apprenticed to a cabinet maker when he first heard the gospel. Until then, he didn't even know there was a God. As he grew into adulthood, he became active in the local church. Mote wrote the chorus of this hymn as he was walking to work one day and later that same day, the stanzas came to him. He quoted the verses to a dying friend before he published it entitling it "The Immutable Basis of a Sinner's Hope."
