"I Surrender All" Hymn History

"J. W. Van De Venter, the author of this hymn, meant it when he wrote the words 'I surrender all'. He was an artist at heart and a school teacher by profession. For five years he wavered between his love for art, his need to support himself and what seemed to be God's calling to evangelistic ministry. He later recalled, "At last the pivotal hour of my life came and I surrendered all. A new day was ushered into my life and I became an evangelist and discovered down deep in my soul a new talent". When he remembered that moment, he wrote the hymn. When we truly surrender all to Jesus, we, too, may discover unknown talents and abilities through our devotion to Him."
