"It Is Well With My Soul" Hymn History

"The 43 year old Horatio Spafford penned this hymn after a year of tremendous tragedy. He and his wife were grieving the loss of their only son when the Great Chicago Fire caused them financial disaster. In the hopes of respite from the stress, he decided to take his wife and four daughters to England. His family went ahead and were planning to meet in a few days. But, the ship the family was on, went down in the Atlantic. More than 200 lives were lost. Including all four of Spafford's daughters. When the survivors were brought ashore, Mrs. Spafford cabled her husband, "Saved alone." He booked passage on the next ship to go to his wife. While crossing the Atlantic himself, he wrote the words to this hymn: "When sorrows like sea billows roll . . . / 'It is well with my soul.'" *The Complete Book of Hymns, c. 2006*
