"All Hail The Power of Jesus' Name" Hymn History

"E.P. Scott, a missionary to India, saw a tribesman on the street and asked where he came from. The man only came once a year from his mountain home to the city to trade. Scott also found that the gospel had never been taken to that man's tribe. Scott prayed, packed his bags and violin, and proceeded to travel for two days to reach the mountain village. When he arrived, he was met by spear-wielding tribesmen pointing at him. He took out his violin and began playing and singing the song, including the verse, "Let every kindred, every tribe, on this celestial ball, to Him all majesty ascribe, and crown Him Lord of all." The spears dropped, tears came to some of the men's eyes. Scott spent the next 2 years of his life telling them about Jesus and His love for them. When he had to leave due to poor health, the men of the tribe escorted him through the mountains for forty miles to where he could get other transportation." The Complete Book of Hymns, c. 2006.
