"Holy, Holy, Holy" Hymn History

"Reginal Heber was always trying to improve the music at the Anglican church in which he served in Hodnet, England. He introduced hymns and even wrote new hymns of his own even though his superiors frowned upon it. "Holy, Holy, Holy" is one of his hymns. Alfred Lord Tennyson called it the "world's greatest hymn." Heber served 16 years in England and then became Bishop to Calcutta, India. He died there after only 3 years of service, but he was impressed by the holiness of God there where he was surrounded by the worship of false gods just as much as he was in England in face of vice among men. He believed and wrote, "only Thou art Holy" from his heart." The Complete Book of Hymns, c. 2006
