## "At Calvary" Hymn History

"William R. Newell was best known as a Bible teacher and as the writer of a commentary on the book of Romans. One day on his way to class at Moody Bible Institute in Chicago, the words of this hymn began to form in his mind. He went into an empty classroom and jotted them down on the back of an envelope before he forgot them. Continuing to his class, he ran into the school's director of music, Daniel B. Towner, and gave him the envelope. By the time Newell's class was over an hour later, Towner had finished composing the music for the gospel song. The verses follow the outline of Romans. The first stanza deals with our sinfulness, the second with God's law and with the cross, the third with our salvation, and the fourth with praise to God for His goodness."
