"Jesus, Keep Me Near The Cross" Hymn History

"Which comes first, the words or the music? Most of the time, the words come first. The blind hymnwriter, Fanny Crosby, wrote eight thousand hymn texts. She often wrote her lyrics and sent them to a musician to set to music. But, on occasion, she worked the other way. In the case of this hymn, the composer, William Doane, wrote the music and asked Crosby did it suggest anything to her. The tune somehow reminded Crosby of the cross and how important it is in our lives. Without the Cross, there would be no salvation, no eternal life, no hope. If we don't stay near the Cross, we lose our focus in life.
