## "Crown Him With Many Crowns" Hymn History

"A Roman Catholic, Matthew Bridges, and an Anglican Cleric, Godfrey Thring, separated by 30 years, co-wrote this hymn about heaven, where Christians of every tribe and tongue and denomination will crown him Lord of all. One aspect in the original hymn missing by Bridges, was a stanza on the resurrection, so Thring added the 2nd stanza. At a large gathering in London in 1905, the Bible Society was congratulating rulers from many lands including Great Britain and the U. S. when the moderator said, "Now that we have read these addresses from earthly rulers, let us turn our minds to the King of Kings. We'll sing, "Crown Him With Many Crowns."
