From the Pastor's Desk: "TOPPLE EVERY IDOL" By John Piper

There is no difference between the Hebrew word for "desire" and the Hebrew word for "covet." Coveting means "desiring something too much." And too much is measured by how that desiring compares to desiring God. If desiring leads you away from God rather than closer to God, it is covetousness. It is sin.

Not coveting means not desiring anything in a way that diminishes God as your supreme treasure. And not having any gods before God means the same thing: Don't treasure anything or anyone in a way that competes with God's supreme place in your life. Idolatry is what we call disobedience to the first commandment. And idolatry is what Paul called disobedience to the tenth commandment ("covetousness, which is idolatry," Colossians 3:5).

How can we keep our lives free from this dreadful condition – desiring other things more than God, coveting, being idolaters?

- 1. One answer is the Word of God: "I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you." (Psalm 119:11)
- 2. Another answer comes from Philippians. Paul described the condition we all want to be in. He said, "Whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord" (Philippians 3:7-8). That is exactly the opposite of covetousness. That is the opposite of idolatry. That is supreme satisfaction in Christ. That is freedom.
- 3. Does Paul have a practical suggestion that we can use to fight for this satisfaction in Christ? Yes, he does: "Brothers, join in imitating me, and keep your eyes on those who walk according to the example you have in us: (Philippians 3:17). Pick out some people whose lives show that they treasure Christ above other things. Then keep your eyes on them, as Paul said. Watch them. That is a good way to conquer covetousness.

So flee covetousness. Topple all your idols. "Count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ." Be in the Word every day. But also find those who live this way and "keep your eyes on them." What you will see, if you look carefully, is the power and beauty of Christ. This sight will satisfy your soul. And your satisfied soul will keep you from coveting and your life will make God look supremely valuable.

We are currently learning from the books of Galatians and Ephesians – what God has done for us and who we are in Christ. Please come and join the discussion!






Crisis Pregnancy Center





Saturday Morning Men's Prayer Breakfast and Bible Study

The Saturday Morning Men's Breakfast and Bible Study continues to meet on the first and third Saturdays of each month. This month we will meet on March 6th and March 20th and will conclude our in-depth study and discussion of the **Book of Ephesians** with a chapter by chapter, verse by verse, word by word, comprehensive study of **Chapters 5** and **6**.

In **Chapter 5**, Paul gives instruction in Christian living as "imitators of Christ" by walking in love, as Christ loved us;" engaging in nothing of an impure or immoral nature. He further gives instruction for relationships between wives and husbands and, in **Chapter 6**, between children and parents.



Also in **Chapter 6**, Paul admonishes Christians to "put on" and to "take up the whole armor of God" so as "to withstand" and "to stand firm" against ungodly schemes and to "keep alert with all perseverance."

The Men's Breakfast and Bible Study is an outstanding opportunity for the study of God's Word, prayer, and fellowship for men of all ages; church members and non-members.

Operation Christmas Child Corner

Thank you to those who have been bringing in donations for the shoebox gifts! We have a good start on our collection already. The biggest need that is upcoming is the empty boxes. Try to collect as many as you can from friends or stores that you can. To purchase the printed cardboard shoe boxes from Samaritan's Purse, it is \$25.00/box of 50 plus a \$14.00 shipping fee. You can order them online and have them shipped directly to the church if you wish. We will need lots of boxes, in 2020 we used 574.

The other thing we are working toward is fully funding the shipping donations for our boxes. The suggested donation is \$9.00/ box. For 500 boxes, that adds up to \$4,500.00. If we start saving now, we will have enough by this year's collection date. If you donate online, please let us know how many boxes you funded so we will be able to tell how much more is needed.

Operation Christmas Child Update

MISSION NOT IMPOSSIBLE

If any place can be called the end of the earth it's Wotje—a tiny atoll (a ring-shaped reef, island, or chain of islands formed of coral) that is part of the Marshall Islands in the North Pacific. This past summer, 340 children—most of them orphans—attended a festive Operation Christmas Child outreach event and received gift-filled shoeboxes. Many of them didn't know what a gift was until they lifted the lid of their box. "Through the gifts you can see the brightness in their eyes and the excitement they see when they discover that someone really loves them," one ministry partner said. "It's the love of God in a tangible way. You feel it right there in front of them in their hands. They are overwhelmed."

HOW TO: Using the YouVersion Bible App for your iPhone or Android


<u>Key Features</u> – Verse of the Day, Verse of the Day image to share, Verse of the Day story with devotional, access to thousands of devotional plans, electronic Bible in many languages & versions.

- *Head to your phone's "store" where you can download apps.
- *Search for YouVersion Bible App. It may come up as The Bible App Free from Life.Church (the icon is a brown Bible with the words **Holy Bible** on it).
- *Choose to Install
- *Once your app is installed, you will need to create an account. It will ask for an email address & password.
- *To view the daily verse devotional, click on the "open story" button. You will see a Welcome statement, the scripture verse, a video by someone explaining the verse in more depth, a reflection page, a devotional page, a prayer, the daily verse image, and closing statement.
- *To click through each page simply tap on the right side of the page.
- *There is a "Plans" tab at the bottom. Click on this to find a devotional plan that suites you.
- *There are plans that cover just about every topic you could want. Simply scroll down to find the plan you want to start. You can even do multiple plans at the same time!
- *The "Read" tab will give you access to the Bible. You can choose the language and version of the Bible, as well as changing the font style & size. There is also an option for you to hear the verse being read to you. While you are in a specific verse (1 Corinthians 10: 12 for example), at the top right corner you will see an icon that looks like a black dot with a flat diamond shape inside it. Tap that to access videos related to that verse.
- *You can also highlight verses to save them by holding your finger on the first word of the verse for a second, once you lift your finger, the highlighter option should come up. You can choose what color highlighter you want to use as well as make notes or bookmark.

This app is full of useful things to help you keep your ideas in one place, your favorite verses handy and you will always have your Bible at your fingertips. Play around with it and have fun exploring!
