"Jesus Paid It All" Hymn History

"Elviina Hall wrote this hymn when she should have been listening to her pastor preach. Instead, while she sat in the choir loft, she jotted down four stanzas on the flyleaf of her hymnal. She had no chorus at that time. The church organist, John T. Grape, later composed the music. He had music written for a tune with a refrain that surprisingly fit the rhythm of Hall's words, except there was a refrain included. So Hall wrote a refrain to fit: 'Jesus paid it all,/ All to Him I owe;/ Sin had left a crimson stain-/ He washed it white as snow.' " The Complete Book of Hymns, c. 2006
