#### "Brethren, We Have Met to Worship" Hymn History

"The author of "Brethren, We Have Met to Worship", George Atkins, was born in Ireland, immigrated to the United States and served as a Methodist minister. During his life, he wrote over 1000 hymns and songs. This hymn presents two aspects of worship: preaching and prayer. Prayer unleashes the power of God and preaching yields and displays that power. The result of prayerful worship is 'manna from heaven'. God fed the Israelites in the desert with bread from heaven and Jesus gave his body as the bread of life. This hymn, one of the oldest American folk hymns, helps us to celebrate God's provision for us and to thank Him for it." The Complete Book of Hymns c. 2006
