"At the Cross" Hymn History

"Isaac Watts, born July 17, 1674 and died November 25, 1748, was an English Christian minister, hymn writer, theologian, and logician. He was a productive and popular hymn writer and is credited with roughly 750 hymns. He is recognized as the 'Godfather of English Hymnody'; many of his hymns are still in use today. Watts introduced a new style for hymns in church services, suggesting that they be adapted for original songs of Christian experience. Until then, Psalms, the poetry of the Old Testament was the only hymns sung in church. Hence this hymn, telling of how Jesus bled and died for us and how by faith we can receive Him in our hearts today.
