### "Abide With Me" Hymn History

"It was the author of this hymn who coined the phrase "It is better to wear out than to rust out." For much of his adult life, Henry Lyte was the pastor of a poor church in Devonshire, England. It was a discouraging pastorate, but he kept at it. When he wrote this hymn, he knew he was dying of tuberculosis and asthma and he felt very much alone. Lyte was inspired by the words of the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. They were met by Jesus and invited him to stay with them because it was getting late. "Abide with us for it is toward evening" (Luke 24:29). The aging pastor knew that it was getting late in his own life and he would wear out rather than rust out. Shortly after he wrote this hymn, he preached his last sermon; he was so ill that he practically crawled to the pulpit. The hymn concludes, "In life, in death, O Lord, abide with me".
