"He Lives" Hymn History

"Alfred Ackley was a cellist by training but was also a minister of the gospel serving Presbyterian churches. The gospel song "He Lives" was written after a question was posed to Ackley by a young Jewish student: 'Why should I worship a dead Jew?' Ackley answered quickly, 'He lives! I tell you He is not dead, but lives here and now! Jesus Christ is more alive today than ever before. I can prove it by my own experience as well as the testimony of countless thousands.' Ackley spoke further with the young man then went home and re-read the resurrection stories from the Gospels. He then sat down at his piano and composed the hymn. He said, "The thought of His ever-living presence brought the music promptly and easily." The Complete Book of Hymns, c. 2006
