"Isaac Watts loved children and loved his own childhood years. He was a precocious child. He learned Latin when he was four, Greek when he was eight, French when he was eleven and Hebrew when he was thirteen. As an adult, he wrote books on theology, psychology, logic and astronomy and he wrote a book of children's songs which included this hymn. Today it is considered a song for adults. The first lesson a child should learn is a lesson an adult should never forget; that the great God who created this vast universe loves us and keeps us in His care. This song teaches that lesson."
