"The author of this hymn, George Young, was a carpenter and a pastor. He didn't make much money from either profession but finally was able to build a home for he and his wife in a small farming community. Shortly thereafter, while leading worship in another small town, his home caught fire and burned to the ground. It was probably out of that experience that Young wrote this hymn and ended it with: "some thru great sorrow, but God gives a song, In the night season and all the day long." *Amazing Grace* by Kenneth Osbeck.
