He wrote more than 1,000 songs and tunes, he composed about thirty cantatas which sold more than ten million copies, he has edited and compiled many hymnals and served as president of the Singspiration Music Company. In 1961, he led a singing in Montrose, Pennsylvania and asked people to stand and give their testimonies. An elderly gentleman responded and as he spoke, his face glowed when he recounted the night when he came to Jesus Christ. The way he expressed it was "Heaven came down, and glory filled my soul."
