### "Living For Jesus" Hymn History

"Charles Lowden of Camden, New Jersey, owned a music business and wrote music for gospel songs. He once wrote a song for a children's day service and after it was performed decided the words didn't fit the music as well as he would like. So, he put the music on a shelf to work on again at a later date. Several years later, Thomas Chisholm, a well-known Christian songwriter moved into the area and Lowden retrieved the music he'd written and asked if Thomas could fit some words to it possibly about living for Jesus. Chisholm replied that he would try and two weeks later Lowden received the words he wanted and the hymn, "Living for Jesus" was born.." The Complete Book of Hymns c. 2006
