"I'D Rather Have Jesus" Hymn History

"George Beverly Shea's mother placed a poem by Rhea Miller on the family piano in the hopes that her son, Bev, would read it and make some changes in his life. He was headed for a life singing popular music for NBC. Everyone who heard him was impressed and Bev was lured by the possibilities. When he read the poem, the words moved Shea to sit down at the piano and work out a tune. His mother heard him singing and asked him to sing it at church the following day. So the words by Miller and the tune by Shea became cemented together. A few years later, Bev became associated with evangelist Billy Graham and sang the hymn around the world." *The Complete Book of Hymns* c. 2006
