"He Leadeth Me, O Blessed Thought" Hymn History

"During the Civil War, Joseph Gilmore, a pastor from Philadelphia's First Baptist Church, wanted to bring some hope to his congregation so he turned to Scripture. Psalm 23 helped him to write this hymn. The important thing, he told his congregation, is to know that God is leading, no matter how or where He is leading us. He gave the hymn to his wife and forgot about it. Three years later, he was leafing through a church hymnal in Rochester, New York, where he was a pastoral candidate and spotted his own hymn. What he didn't know was that his wife had submitted the hymn to a Christian periodical and that it had been set to music and published.
