Her many favorites such as "Blessed Assurance" have been an important part of evangelical worship for the past century. Only eternity will disclose the host of individuals whose lives have been spiritually enriched through the texts of her many hymns. Engraved on her tombstone in Bridgeport, Connecticut, are these words taken from our Lord's remarks to Mary, sister of Lazarus, after she had anointed Him with costly perfume - "She hath done what she could."
