"I Love To Tell The Story" Hymn History

"Sharing our personal faith should be a joyful experience just as it was to Kate Hankey, author of this hymn's text. Kate grew up in a wealthy English family and was very active in church, starting many Sunday School classes for rich and poor throughout London. However, when she was 30 years old, she became very ill and had a long period of recovery. During that time of forced idleness, she wrote a lengthy poem on the life of Christ, consisting of two sections, each 50 verses long. The first section was entitled "The Story Wanted" and was adapted to another of Hankey's hymns, "Tell Me The Old, Old Story" and the second section was titled, "The Story Told" and later became the basic part of "I Love To Tell The Story"." *Amazing Grace* by Kenneth Osbeck.
