"One of the earnest concerns of many of our present day spiritual leaders is Biblical ignorance of so many church people. Yet, the churches that do teach and preach the Scripture diligently and apply those teachings to everyday life, are the ones that experience the greatest growth. We never outgrow our need for the Bible. It becomes more precious with each passing year. Philip P. Bliss was one of the most important names in the development of early Gospel music.
