"Sometimes called the "National Anthem of Christendom", this is one of the truly great worship hymns of the church. Written by a young English minister, it has been translated into almost every language where Christianity is known. The strong exuberant lines lead us in heartfelt worship of God each time we sing them. The author, Edward Perronet, came from a family of distinguished French Huguenots who had fled from Switzerland to England to escape religious persecution. He was ordained to ministry in the Anglican church but was always sympathetic to the evangelical movement.
