"The Love Of God" Hymn History

"This hymn has a rich history. It can be traced back almost 1000 years to a Jewish hymn written in Aramaic by Meir Ben Isaac Nehora, a cantor in Germany. From there it was next seen scribbled on the wall of a patient's room in an insane asylum. Then, in 1900, a Nazarene pastor, Frederick Lehman, heard the words quoted at a camp meeting and decided to adapt them into a hymn. Being moved to preserve the words for future generations, he sat down upon an empty lemon box and added the first two stanzas and the chorus to the song.
