"When he was in his teens, Mark Altrogge was planning to make rock and roll music his life's work. If the Beatles could do it, why couldn't he? But, then, at the age of 24, Mark became a Christian and realized he would surrender himself totally to Jesus Christ. Now, his attention became fixed, not on the Beatles, but on God. He began to read and study books about the knowledge and holiness of God and discovered, God is infinite. Mark said, "We will never come to an end of learning new things about Him.
