"Leaning On The Everlasting Arms" Hymn History

"Music Teacher, A.J. Showalter of Alabama received two letters from former students on the same day. The letters were amazingly similar. Both young men had lost their wives and even more coincidental, on the same day. As Showalter began to compose letters of condolence to the men, he remembered a Scripture verse from Deuteronomy, giving the assurance of God's "everlasting arms" supporting us. He then wrote a third letter. This one to a hymnwriter he knew in Pennsylvania, Elisha Hoffman. He suggested the wording of a chorus from that Scripture and Hoffman quickly wrote three stanzas and sent them back to Showalter who composed the music. The theme is simple: With God's arms around and under us, we can find the strength to go on even in the most sorrowful situations." *The Complete Book of Hymns* c. 2006
