"The Star Spangled Banner" Hymn History

"Francis Scott Key was an attorney in Washington, D.C. when the War of 1812 broke out. President James Madison asked Key to negotiate the release of a physician who had been taken prisoner by the British. Even though he was granted permission to visit by the British Admiral, due to the eminent attack on Fort McHenry and Baltimore, Key was detained overnight aboard a truce boat. Key paced the deck all night and as dawn broke, it brought shafts of light and revealed "the broad stripes and bright starts" of the flag flying over the fort. That day, Francis wrote the first draft of "The Star Spangled Banner" on the back of an envelope and before the day was over, it was printed and circulated all over Baltimore.
