"Great Is Thy Faithfulness" Hymn History

"Thomas Chisholm had his share of disappointment in his life. Born in poverty in a log cabin in Kentucky, he never went to high school or college. His health was fragile, forcing him to resign as a Methodist minister after only one year of service. He began writing but received many rejection letters. Even when his poems were published, he seldom received any payment. At the age of 57, he wrote this hymn. When asked what inspired him, he replied, "Nothing special. I'd been reading Lamentations where it says 'His compassions, they fail not. They are new every morning; great is Thy faithfulness'" (3:22-23) and he simply wrote about what he had read." *Amazing Grace* by Kenneth Osbeck. C. 1990.
