"Tis So Sweet To Trust In Jesus" Hymn History

"One day, as Louisa Stead and her small family relaxed on the beach on Long Island, New York, they heard a cry from the water. A young boy was in trouble. Louisa's husband jumped in to try to rescue the boy, leaving his wife and 4 year old daughter on the sand. Unfortunately, the panicked boy pulled Mr. Stead under and both tragically drowned. They were left with no means of support and experienced dire poverty. As Louisa struggled to make ends meet, one morning she woke to no food or funds to buy any for the day. As she started out the door to find help, she stumbled over a package of food and money someone had left for them. That day she wrote the words to this song. Her hymn remains a timeless reminder and comfort to all believers who have experienced this truth: "Jesus, Jesus, how I trust Him / How I've proved Him o'er and o'er."
