### "Jesus, I Come" Hymn History

"William Sleeper was a church planter. He spent most of his life moving from town to town, starting and establishing churches where none existed. He eventually returned to take a pastorate at one of the first churches he planted in Worcester, Massachusetts. When Sleeper was nearly sixty years old, he met a young song leader, George Stebbins at an evangelistic crusade and collaborated on the words to an invitation song called, "Ye Must Be born Again". Later, William had an idea himself for a song that would start, "Out of my bondage, sorrow and night" and have a chorus of "Jesus, I Come". He wrote out the words and sent them to his young friend, Stebbins, to provide some music. Thus, another gospel song was born." *Amazing Grace* by Kenneth Osbeck. C. 1990.
