"Blessed Be The Name" Hymn History

"Written by Charles Wesley, this hymn encompasses the very nature of God. In biblical times, names were sacred. Names expressed character. We often find Old Testament names changed to reflect New Testament values. For instance, Jacob (the grabber) became Israel (God's prince) after a divine encounter. God's name was so holy and revered that ancient scribes would not even write it. Instead, they referred to "Yahweh" or "Lord". When Isaiah predicted the coming of the Redeemer, he called Him, "Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace," he was saying that this would be the Messiah's nature. These characteristics are associated with the members of the Trinity. Three names, three persons, in one God. So when we bless God's name, we are praising God for who He is." The Complete Book of Hymns, c. 2006
