"Rock Of Ages, Cleft For Me" Hymn History

"It may seem strange that such a sedate hymn was written by a feisty, pugnacious man named August Toplady from Dublin. He was a converted Methodist, but disagreed strongly with Wesleyan theology. He was impressed with he spirit of Methodism but waged a running battle with the Wesleys through sermons, tracts and even hymns. Toplady reportedly said of Charles Wesley, "Wesley is guilty of Satan's shamelessness." Wesley retorted, "I do not fight with chimney sweeps!" August wrote "Rock of Ages" at the end of a magazine article in which he emphasized that just as England would never repay its national debt, so humans could never satisfy the eternal justice of God through their own efforts. He died at 38 of tuberculosis and overwork just 2 years after he published his own hymnal with "Rock Of Ages" placed beside Charles Wesley's "Jesus, Lover of My Soul."
