"Jesus, I Come" Hymn History

"William Sleeper was a church planter. This meant he would get a church started in one place, finding ministers and staff to grow the church, then move on to another town where a church was needed. When he was 60 years old and pastoring one of his earlier planted churches, a young song leader asked for help with words for an invitation melody he had composed and "Ye must Be Born Again" was born. Later, Sleeper came up with an idea for another invitation beginning with "out of my bondage, sorrow and night" and to have a chorus of "Jesus, I Come." He sent the lyrics to his young friend, Stebbins, to provide the music and another great hymn came to be." The Complete Book of Hymns, c. 2006
