### "Come, Ye Thankful People, Come" Hymn History

"Many of us habitually give thanks before a meal. Henry Alford also gave thanks AFTER meals, standing and offering his gratitude to God for the blessings just received. He also gave thanks at the beginning and end of every day. He was one of the 'thankful people' that he writes about in this hymn. But the song isn't just about thanksgiving for what God has done. It is also about work completed and a job well done. It was written to be used at the many harvest festivals in villages throughout England. Alford, one of the leading English churchmen in the nineteenth century, provided this hymn of thanks. It was originally called "After Harvest". The Complete Book of Hymns, c. 2006.
