"Rejoice The Lord Is King" Hymn History

"One reason Charles Wesley wrote six thousand hymns was to encourage Methodists to be a joyful, singing people. Paul's letter to the Philippians provided his text for this one. As Paul concludes his letter, he reminds Christians to "rejoice in the Lord always, and again I say rejoice" in whatever circumstances they find themselves. You can be a victor regardless of the situation because the Lord is King! Each stanza of "Rejoice, the Lord is King" adds another dimension to our praise, adoration, thanksgiving, and exultation."
