## "How Great Thou Art" Hymn History

"In 1885, Carl Bobert, a 26 year old Swiss preacher, wrote a poem entitled "O Store Gud." Translated into English it means "O Great God." Never did Boberg think that his poem would become one of the most popular hymns of all times. A generation later, in the early 1920's, an English missionary Stuart Hines, was serving in Poland when he heard the hymn sung in Russian. He translated it to English and arranged the Swedish melody to fit the words. This is how the hymn we know as "How Great Thou Art" came to be. The song became popular in America in the 1950's inspired by the wonders around Hines in the Carpathian mountains as he continued to serve the Lord.
