#### "Lead Me To Calvary" Hymn History

"The writer of this hymn was Jennie Hussey, a Quaker from rural New Hampshire. She spent most of her life caring for her invalid sister and was known for her cheerful and courageous attitude. Jennie could trace her roots all the way back to the 18th century, almost to the time of the founding of the Pennsylvania colony by the remarkable Quaker, William Penn. Penn wrote a Quaker classic entitled, "No Cross, No Crown" which could possibly explain why Jennie began her hymn with the words, "King of my life, I crown thee now," and ended it with "Lead me to Calvary". The Complete Book of Hymns, c. 2006
