"Praise To The Lord, The Almighty" Hymn History

"As a student in Germany, Joachin Neander lived a Godless life. He wasted his teenage years in immorality. Then, when he was 20, he was converted to Christianity by a traveling preacher named, Under-Eyke. Four years later, he was dismissed as headmaster of a school in Dusseldorf where Neander had written over 60 hymns because of his strong Christian views and evangelistic activities. After his dismissal, he lived for a time in a cave, but continued to write hymns of praise. Neander died very young, at age 30, in 1680, but he left behind a legacy of praise to God including this hymn still sung today." The Complete Book of Hymns, c. 2006
