"Holy Ground" Hymn History

"Geron Davis was a typical teenager except he was a pastor's kid who liked to write music. One day, his dad asked him to write a new song to dedicate their new church building. For weeks, his Dad asked if he had finished the song and Geron would answer not yet, but I'm working on it. At almost midnight the day before the dedication service, Geron went into the new sanctuary and asked himself, "What do we want to say tomorrow when we come into this room for our first worship service?" And in 15 minutes, he had written the entire song with the music. He taught it to his younger siblings and they sang it the next morning at the service. He was nineteen.
